## HOW TO GET TO...

### ... Nuremberg

As international transport hub Nuremberg can easily be reached by plane, train or car. Nuremberg Airport is served by several airlines and is connected to major German cities and many European destinations. If more convenient or the price is more reasonable, you can also book a flight to Frankfurt or Munich and continue your journey to Nuremberg by train. If you want to arrive by car, Nuremberg is conveniently located at the junction of the important Autobahn routes A3, A6 and A9.

### ... Maritim Hotel

**Taxi fares from airport:** approx. €15 - 20 (generally not reimbursed)

#### **From the airport to central station:**

Take subway line U2 from "Flughafen" (airport) in the direction of "Röthenbach" to "Hauptbahnhof" (central station).

#### **From central station to Maritim Hotel:**

Follow the signs to "Bahnhofsplatz" (located in front of the central station). Continue left on "Frauentorgraben" street. The Maritim Hotel is located on the left hand side. At the Maritim Hotel you can leave your luggage in deposit. The check-in will take place on the evening of the first conference day.

### ... the conference

There will be a bus shuttle to the conference leaving in front of the Maritim Hotel on Thursday at 12.40.

If you want to get directly to the conference from the central station or airport, take subway line U2 in the direction of "Röthenbach" to "Röthenbach". Transfer to the 63 bus in the direction of "Goethering" or to the 64 bus in the direction of "Fabergut" to "Stein Schloss". You can see the Faber-Castell Castle directly from the bus stop.
